The Good Samaritan Fund is available to residents of the Cannon Valley area. The GSF is maintained by the Community Churches Interaction Council (CCIC) to help meet one time emergency needs of individuals and families in our community, such as overdue rent, utility bills, etc. A majority of the contributions come from churches, as well as concerned citizens in our community. The GSF is accessed primarily through referrals by churches or word of mouth. Police referrals also give one-time assistance for those traveling through town for gas, a meal, or a night in a motel.
