

You are a king, then!" said Pilate. Jesus answered, "You are right in saying I am a king. In fact, for this reason I was born, and for this I came into the world, to testify to the truth. Everyone on the side of truth listens to me."
(John 18:37)

'Let us agree to disagree', is a statement that has often been used to end a disagreement or move on to another topic for discussion. Think of the various times you have encountered this phase in a conversation. Has it been used as an escape mechanism where a participant has little interest in the subject and does not want to discuss it anymore? Has it been used when there is no available reasonable response to a challenging argument and the opposing viewpoint does not want to accept a differing thought? Has it been used to affirm a person with opposing views without dismissing a differing view? Has it been used to diminish the importance of the opposing views to elevate the value of shared views? The answer to these differing reasons for using the phrase, 'Let us agree to disagree', is born out of our perceived relationship to ourself, to others and to God.

When you peel back the layers of the statement, 'Let us agree to disagree', there can be a very dangerous assumption at the statement's core. That assumption is: there is no absolute truth. God's Holy Word is the absolute truth from which we interact with ourselves, our relationships and our world. From God's Holy Word, our sinful human self can misunderstand or interpret this absolute truth. Conversations with others who hold to God's Word as absolute truth can yield insight, understanding, transformation and reconciliation. *"Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, they are a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come! All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation: that God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting men's sins against them. And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation."* (2 Corinthians 5:17-19) Discussions based on Scripture will always have an element of hope for a shared understanding of truth. Discussions based on feelings, personal perceptions, and unscriptural truth claims will always create divisions. When there is no absolute truth then any truth claim can be given authority or multiple truth claims can be given authority.

The next time you hear or want to say, 'Let us agree to disagree,' think about how you are being an image bearer of God before you respond.




